

THE OTA PROFESSIONAL DRIVER MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP

The Ontario Trucking Association (OTA) is pleased to sponsor an annual scholarship to aid a university student who is the son or daughter of a professional commercial truck driver. The scholarship honours the memory of David Virgoe, a truck driver and truck hero who died in June, 2007 in a crash caused by street racers on Highway 400. It also recognizes the hard work, dedication, and professionalism of all Ontario truck drivers who safely share the road with the general motoring public every day.

The scholarship recipient will be selected by the OTA Education Foundation Selection Committee. The maximum scholarship amount is \$1,000.

Eligibility Criteria

In order to be considered for a scholarship, each applicant must be:

- Twenty-five (25) years of age or under as of January 1st of the academic year for which the application applies.
- Enrolled in or registered to attend a public Ontario university on a full-time basis.
- A resident of Ontario.
- The child of a commercial driver (employee or owner-operator) who has been driving professionally for a minimum of 5 years.

Application Requirements

The following must be submitted by **July 15th**:

- A completed *OTA Professional Driver Memorial Scholarship* application form. Applications received by fax or email will not be eligible, unless submitted only to meet the application deadline. However, ***original forms and documents must be submitted by mail.***
- A type-written essay of 500 words or less that describes why you think your parent is an outstanding professional driver (e.g., accident free, driving awards, acts of bravery, etc.).
- A type-written letter of 500 words or less addressed to the *OTA Education Foundation Selection Committee* that describes your personal and academic accomplishments, as well as your personal, academic and career goals along with what motivated you to pursue those goals.

The following must be provided by **July 30th**:

- An ***official*** transcript from your most recent academic year with final (not mid-term) marks, which ***must be sent directly from the issuing institution*** to the OTA Education Foundation at the address below. Students who are applying for multiple *OTA Education Foundation* scholarships are permitted to arrange for only one official transcript to be sent to the Foundation. Applicants are asked to indicate that they are applying for other Foundation scholarships on the application form.

Please Note: Only the scholarship winner will be notified. Scholarship funds will be advanced to the student's post-secondary institution and will be credited to the account identified by the student number provided on the application.
